

The Dr. Joyce Slone Master Teacher Scholarship

Sponsored by Victoria ISD Education Foundation, HEB & William and Madeline Smith Foundation

The Master Teacher Scholarship is named after a VISD teacher with 10 or more years teaching experience and who has had a significant influence on his/her students. Dr. Slone, a Government/Economics and Psychology/Sociology Teacher at Stroman High School for over thirty-two years, was named the 2000 VISD Master Teacher. Dr. Slone states that "education is a life-long process. I did not receive my doctorate until I was 51 years old."



The criteria for this annual scholarship are determined by the Master Teacher. Scholarship funds will be forwarded to the college/university of the student's choice upon enrollment and completion of criteria. **The Dr. Joyce Slone Master Teacher Scholarship is being given on behalf of the Victoria ISD Education Foundation in the amount of \$500.**

Criteria as determined by Dr. Joyce Slone

- *Submittals open to Victoria ISD graduating seniors;*
- *A four year cumulative average of 85 or better;*
- *No more than three absences and/or three tardies per semester within the student's senior year;*
- *No conduct grade below a B and no discipline referrals within the student's senior year—poor conduct, which in the judgment of the VISD Education Foundation, is unbecoming for a scholarship recipient;*
- *Successful completion of at least four charitable projects significant to one's school and/or community;*
- *Involvement in two extracurricular activities (one must include participation in one of the fine arts programs);*
- *Recommendations from two community people (not related) or educators;*
- *Personal vita (biography).*

Scholarship Deadline: Thursday, April 5, 2012

Please submit application in the following order. Items may be bound with a paper clip (no staples or folders): Signature page, application form, personal vita, two letters of recommendation, conduct grades through deadline, certified high school transcript, and additional pages needed to complete this application.

I understand that the Victoria ISD Education Foundation reserves the right to revoke the scholarship funds if I, as the recipient, do not meet the above criteria. Also, I allow the Victoria ISD Education Foundation to request and receive verification from the high school(s) attended confirming personal information provided in this application.
