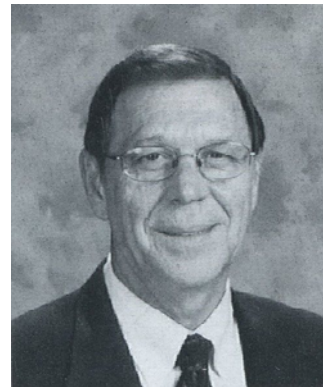


THE 2012 L. C. MIDDLETON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Mr. L. C. Middleton, who is memorialized through this scholarship, worked for the Victoria Independent School District. He passed away suddenly in March 2002 at the age of 57. His positions at VISD included serving as a teacher at Crain Middle School and a principal at Howell Middle School. Prior to his death in the fall of 2001, Mr. Middleton was selected the Region III Secondary Principal of the Year by the Texas Association of Secondary Supervisors and Principals. He was quoted at that time saying, "Every child has the ability to make something of themselves if they put their minds to it." Mr. Middleton gave 35 years of his life to ensuring and cultivating a positive and well-rounded education for youth.



*The criteria for this annual scholarship are noted below. The scholarship award will be forwarded to the college/university of the student's choice upon enrollment. **The L. C. Middleton Memorial Scholarship is being given on behalf of the Victoria ISD Education Foundation in the amount of \$500.***

Scholarship Criteria

- *Submittals open to Victoria ISD graduating seniors;*
- *A four year cumulative average of 85 or better; with no more than three absences and/or three tardies per semester within the student's senior year;*
- *No conduct grade below a B or any discipline referrals within the student's senior year—poor conduct, which in the judgment of the VISD Education Foundation, is unbecoming for a scholarship recipient;*
- *Successful completion of at least two altruistic (charitable) projects significant to one's school and/or community;*
- *A minimum of one extracurricular activity (and been a part of this activity for at least three years);*
- *Recommendations from one community person (not related) and one teacher;*
- *Submission of personal vita (biography).*

Scholarship Deadline: Thursday, April 5, 2012

Please submit application in the following order. Items may be bound with a paper clip (no staples or folders): Signature page, application form, personal vita, letter of recommendation, conduct grades through deadline, certified high school transcript, and additional pages needed to complete this application.

I understand that the VISD Education Foundation reserves the right to revoke the scholarship funds if I, as the recipient, do not meet the above criteria. Also, I allow the VISD Education Foundation to request and receive verification from the high school(s) attended confirming personal information provided in this application.
